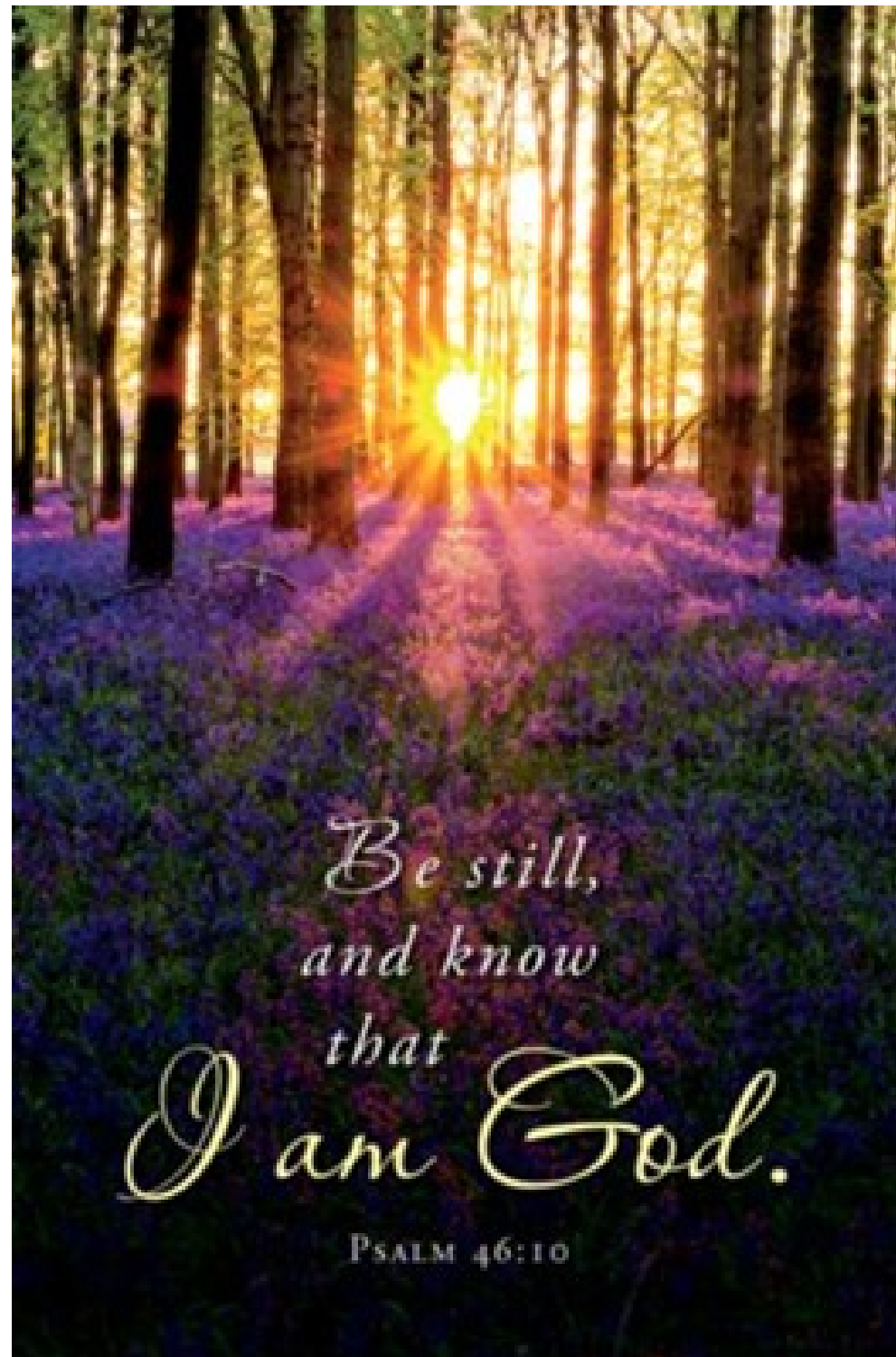

Getting to Know Our Church's Beginning – Part 1

The Church of the Nazarene was built on the principles of John Wesley, which spread to the American colonies in the mid-1700s. John Wesley's three principles became the foundation for the Nazarene Church. Wesley believed that Christians could achieve spiritual perfection, or entire sanctification, as he put it, by grace through faith. This was not salvation by works or earned merit but a gift of "perfection" from God. Under John and Charles Wesley's leadership the Wesleyan Methodist and the Free Methodist church was formed. By the mid-1800s the Holiness movement focused their concern for the deplorable conditions in the urban communities which lead to missions, rescue missions and independent churches. This was the beginning what was known as the Holiness Movement.
